## Remarks

2 hânes only.
All the consulted concordances provide usûl muhammes instead of hafîf, which suggests a transcription error was made by the scribe. The order of the div. signs in H1 and H2 imply a structure of 32 beats, whereas the teslîm section would only comprise 16 beats. Therefore, the editor employed usûl muhammes by splitting the implied cycle of 32 beats into two cycles of 16 beats for H 1 and H 2 according to the concordances. The notation of the usûl is transcribed from the usûl table in TR-Iüne 211-9.
