Remarks

NE214 and TA108 attribute this piece to Kemânî Corci (d. 1805?).

The scribe indicated *mülāzime teslīm*[*dir*] as a performance instruction at the end of H3 and H4. However, none of the musical sections was labelled as mülâzime or teslîm. The scribes of NE214 and TA108 marked H2 with a cross sign, indicating the performance of H2 also after H3. On this basis, the editor indicated H2 as mülâzime.
