- 13 : omit.
- 44.2 The group is partly obscured by the binding. The visible part of the first pitch symbol suggests a vernaxał (v), rather than a xosrovayin-kisver (x) as supplied by TA249 (A): v . Cf. OA353: v .
- 51.2 The group is partly obscured by the binding. The visible part of the first pitch symbol suggests a paroyk (p).
